## Arezoo Monseni

## Biography

American artist, born in Iran, lives and works in New York. She studied with Moishe Smith at Utah State University (1977-1981, BFA), with Garo Antreasian, Thomas Barrow, Betty Hahn and Beaumont Newhall at the University of New Mexico (1981-1984, MA, MFA), and with Dr. Tula Giannini at Pratt Institute (2003-2005, MLIS). Dissertation title *Alberto Giacometti: Presence of Reality*.

In 1988, shortly after her first solo exhibition at The Collector Gallery in Washington, DC, she began working with an 810 field camera, and continuing her work with Vandyke contact prints. She moved to New York in 1990.

In addition to many group exhibitions, numerous solo exhibitions of her work have been shown worldwide including *Float* at the Center for Photography at Woodstock (1992), *New Processes* at the Photographers Gallery in London (1994), *ACH* at UNM Art Museum in Albuquerque (1997), *Storyteller Suite* at The New York Public Library (1999), *Garb* at Halle de l'Ecal in Lausanne, Switzerland (2002) and *Changes* at Kentler International (2011).

Her work is held in the collections of Bibliothèque Nationale, Paris, France; The Brooklyn Museum, Brooklyn, New York; Musèe de la Photographie, Charleroi, Belgium; The Miriam & Ira D. Wallach Photography Collection of The New York Public Library; The Photographers Gallery, London, England; The Print Consortium, Kansas City, Missouri and several other major public collections and many private collections. Her solo exhibitions have been reviewed in numerous publications including *Forward, New Art Examiner, View Camera, The Villager*, and *Zoom International*.

She is a recipient of the Kentler International Exhibition Award (2011), the Carnegie Corporation / New York Times Award (2008), a Pratt Merit Award (2003-05), a Yaddo Fellowship (2002), a Meredith Moody Fellowship (2002), a Saltonstall Foundation Fellowship (2001), an Aljira Emerging Fellowship (2000) and an Artists Space Independent Project Grant (1999). She was short listed for a MacDowell Colony Fellowship in 2006 and 2001, and a Millay Colony Fellowship in 2001.

She has worked at the Art Collection of Mid-Manhattan Library since 1999. Prior to joining The New York Public Library, she managed fundraising campaigns at Lincoln Center and taught art



classes and workshops at International Center of Photography, Northern Virginia College and the University of New Mexico.

She is currently the senior art librarian at the Art collection where she has created a "third place" for the local art community. In addition to her librarian responsibilities, she also curates exhibitions and public art programs at NYPL. She has initiated several popular exhibition and event series featuring world renowned and emerging architects, artists, authors, critics, curators, designers and historians.
